The University of Technology, Sydney offers the following postgraduate Biotechnology courses:

- C09022 Bachelor of Biotechnology (Honours)
A year of postgraduate research in one of Australia's most highly regarded Honours programs. Topics range from gene therapy and cancer research to bioremediation of land. Students from other Universities and recent graduates are welcome
- C03029 Master of Science (Research)
Research degree for students who are not sure if they want to commit to a PhD yet or for students who wish to work part-time. Workplace-based research projects are encouraged.
- C02014 Doctor of Philosophy (by research)
The most common postgraduate research degree, a classic 3 year program. Workplace-based research projects are encouraged. It is possible to enrol on a part-time basis.
- C11150 Graduate Certificate in Science Management (by coursework)
The first portion of the MSc in Science Management, for working biotechnologists.
- C07085 Graduate Diploma in Science Management (by coursework)
The first and second portion of the MSc in Science Management, for working biotechnologists
- C04170 Master of Science Management (by coursework)
A management course for working biotechnologists.
